The Champs were also round 1 of the Australian MTBO Series and Victoria has taken an early lead in the Men's and Women's elite classes.

It was also the selection races for the World Championship Team for 2012 and Round 1 of the Australian MTBO Series.

Victorians Steven Cusworth (BKV) and Heath Jamieson (CH) were selected.

Steven won all 3 races in M21 to make his 4th World Champs team and Heath did well enough in M20 to be selected for his first Junior World Champs.

Alex Randall was also selected subject to fitness – he had broken his collarbone a few weeks before the selection races. Unfortunately Alex has had to withdraw from the team.
