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ACTIVITIES & PLANS

1. The Victorian Junior Orienteering Camp was held on August 10th to 11th at the Koolarmut Scout Camp. The attendance was great with 27 juniors participating. The sessions included training exercises, theory sessions and presentations from JWOC and Victorian elites.

Additional training has been organised by Bruce Arthur from July to late September to enable the juniors to keep the focus on Orienteering on a week by week basis prior to the Australian Carnival in Canberra. This has included short technical session after the State Series events at Jim Crow, Eppalock and Mt Korong. And race de-briefs after the Victorian Champs.
