## VSSOC Best Boys School Shield.

As a result MHS has agreed to pay for full cost of replacement shield. ## Permanent Course – Westerfolds

Re App development for Smart Orienteering.

Jarrah has advised that the company employed to construct the App for use has gone out of business. It was the melbourneappsoftware company.

Jarrah had an agreement with them that 50% of cost would be paid when stage 1 was completed with final 50% payment on completion of job. Stage 1 had not been completed and yet he started receiving demands for full payment.

Soon after he discovered that company was off line and contacts dead.

This is a real set back to completing this project. I have advised Jarrah to follow up on some of the other companies who also tendered for the job, to engage another company and to move the project along.

## SRV - 12 monthly reporting

The 12 monthly report for the 'Four Direction' project was submitted prior to deadline of 30<sup>th</sup> June. It has been accepted. Notice of payments from SRV indicate OV has been successful in obtaining both the \$25,000 for the core of the Victorians More Active project plus an additional \$15,000 for the next 12 months only. This 'additional' payment also applied to 2012 – 2013 but will not be available for 2014-2015. A revised table for 'Agreed actions and payments' has been signed and also filed.
