

Promotion and Development Report For October Council meeting 2013

Schools Team

Victoria has been most successful at the ASOC competition in ACT.

Victoria finished 1st, the first time since 2004.

School sessions

- July - 3 sessions
- August – 4 sessions plus 1 x tertiary
- September – 9 sessions

Sport and Recreation projects (update)

The current funded projects are part of a three year project.

Year 1 = 2012 – 2013 (completed)

Year 2 = 2013 – 2014 (just started)

Year 3 = 2014 – 2015

Brief summary of the 4 pillars (for funding)

1. Participation –

Communications and Media Officer

OV has employed Dennis Mews as its Communications and Media Officer. Dennis' main focus has been on improving the weekly e-bulletin, including increased use of social media – facebook, twitter. Currently he is working with the Bush O Committee to draw up a yearly schedule of bush events to present it in a marketing format. This will be ready for distribution with the final O news in early December.

Permanent Course at Westerfolds – currently awaiting delivery of posts, due 21st October. Installation will be as soon as practicable once the posts have arrived.

2. Membership – the issue of membership registration is now handled thru Eventor. However the linking of event entry to OV membership as an automatic default has yet to be installed. Currently it is clunky with the use of the ‘services’ button. It is hoped this improvement is planned for the immediate future.

An in-depth analysis of the membership system has been undertaken by the Board and the recommendations are to be put to this OV Council meeting. It is hoped for a positive outcome for change, which will be imperative to grow the OV membership in the future.

3. Coaching and Officiating.

Controlling: Over the next 12 months it is planned that further Controlling accreditation opportunities will become available, esp with OA holding Level 3 courses.

Coaching: Peta Whitford is maintaining a steady flow of Level O courses for teachers.

- September – Boronia Hts PS x 2 staff
- October – ACHPER Primary and secondary PE teachers x 9
- October – Sirius College, Keysborough x 12 staff
- November – ACHPER annual conference for PE teachers x 25.

There is a plan for a Level One NCAS course to be offered in early to mid 2014. It is hoped OA will be offering a level 2 NCAS course shortly.

4. Club Capacity:

It is pleasing to record that 8 clubs have taken part in the Club Help review. Only 3 Clubs to go!

Held at Cardinia Reservoir Park on Friday 4th October....for Adli Stores – Transport division.

ASC Market segmentation project –

to increase participation of primary school aged students. (Boronia Heights Primary School). This project is well underway and on schedule.

School has been mapped, staff ‘in-serviced’ with professional development course in how to establish a successful orienteering program in the school. Lead teacher has established a 5 x series of lessons based in the schoolgrounds for Grade 5 students. (3 classes x 25 students total).

On Tuesday 15th Oct these students attended their first Park Orienteering session which included ‘Space Racing’. Following this, a school team will be selected to attend VPSOC 2013 at Maroondah Reservoir Park in November.
