### Licenced Tour Operator (LTO)

As of March 13<sup>th</sup> 2013 the Orienteering Victoria Schools Program is registered by Parks Victoria and DSE as a LTO.

This LTO status has provided OV with the opportunity to apply for the waiving of the TLO licence fee and the user fees for each participants. Application has been made. Awaiting outcome.

### Use of Eventor for OV membership registration

Approximately 75% of OV members managed to register successfully with the new EVENTOR online membership system this year. A reminder ALL your details need to be included- this database is the central data base for email addresses/ home addresses, telephone contacts. Please check your entry next time you open Eventor....there are many people with only partial information supplied.

The remaining 25% of OV membership have been provided with 'transition' options. The option to be encouraged is to learn how to use Eventor. Each Club has a member who has attended training and will help. Take time over the next 6 months to master the Eventor system...the more you use it, the easier it is to use!
