#### ACTIVITIES & PLANS

- A set of OV controls are being sent (via post) to WA for Aus Champs carnival.
- Updated O-Lynx Touch program was released this week will be tested at Sunday MelBushO, trialling completely paperless registration (pay, dip, run). My ultimate aim is for all non-championship SI events to be managed with exactly the same system, either a pre-entry version or a non-pre-entry version, regardless as to whether it is SS, MelBushO or Sprint Series. Organisers continue to mistakenly think that, tech wise, SS has to be run like it was a Championship event. This is overkill as we are getting the same numbers of entrants to MelBushO events now (and far more newbies who need help).
- Water seals on OV controls have now failed on 5 units. I have received some advice on possible fix options to try before scrapping them. If fixes do not work may need to buy some more spares (I only have a couple left now).
- Batteries on 3 OV laptops are not holding charge. I still see value in the older laptops so I think I will just buy some new batteries (cost about \$60-\$160 depending on how many are needed).
- The newer OS2010 relay software has (still) not yet been purchased but will be prior to the next relay event. The idea of negotiating licences with Stephan Kramer on a national basis is unlikely to eventuate (unless I attempt it.)
