

Bush Orienteering Committee Report to OV Council October 2014 – by Mark Hennessy

Decisions required:

- 1 Council to note version 5 of the draft bush orienteering program of events for 2015 (see spreadsheet).
- 2 Council is asked to appoint a Bush Subcommittee convenor.
- 3 Council is asked to note the details of events for the 2015 Australian Championships carnival (attached)

The last bush O Committee meeting was held on 3 May 2014. The committee has not met since the last Council meeting.

New Convenor needed

Mark Hennessy is acting as Convenor of the sub-committee, pending the appointment of a convenor. This is mainly a secretarial and leadership role; it is not a technical role. No specialist technical knowledge is needed. However, the convenor needs to be able to anticipate and respond to emerging issues in bush orienteering.

Mark Hennessy intends to concentrate on coordinating planning for bush orienteering events for the 2015 Australian Championships Carnival.

2015 Pocket Guide to Bush Orienteering

It is expected that the pocket guide for 2015 will be designed and printed early in 2015, as soon as the State Series, Bendigo and AWOC series are finalised. Layout will be generally similar to the 2014 pocket guide.

Class winners for State Series

State Series raw scores are on Eventor. Some additional calculations are required (eg controllers' points). The awards can then be presented on a suitable occasion. We have not managed to develop an award system based on age. Assistance with organising the awards will be gratefully accepted.

Tier 4	Organises people and equipment, schedules, briefs and troubleshoots. Assist with publicity and communications
Tier 5	Plan courses, tag sites, check sites, finalise courses to printer, allocate codes, put markers out in forest, supervise retrieval
Tier 5	If required
Tier 6	Supervisor of start, finish/results, parking, set up of infrastructure; customer service (registration etc); string course organiser.
Tier 7	Deputy finish tent coordinator; deputy start supervisor; deputy customer service coordinator
