

Sportident assets of Orienteering Victoria

I have lost interest in continuing to coordinate the OV SI gear. Traditionally you have an orienteering job until you can find a replacement for yourself. I plan to circumvent this by making the position redundant.

Increasingly the OV SI assets are only needed for:

- P&D and Schools activities
- Major events
- Clubs without SI gear

Under my strategic direction for Victoria (see other paper), clubs without SI gear will disappear. Leaving just the first two needs. This is the basis for the following recommendations on what to do with each asset currently held:

Controls

OV to retain. Divide into two sets, each sufficient to run a small event (up to and including state series) or available to supplement club gear for a major event (e.g. state championship)

Set 1

1 time master, 2 start, 2 finish, 1 clear, 1 check, 1 download, 2 #100s and other field units #101 to #150 incl. + spares

Set 2

2 start, 2 finish, 1 clear, 1 check, 1 download, 2 #100s and other field units #151 to #200 incl. + spares

The other download controls are assigned to Sprint and MelBushO gear, which is then 2 downloads, 1 touchscreen tablet (OV5), 42 hire sticks

Laptops

OV1, OV2 and/or OV3 assigned to P&D/Schools if needed, else sell to clubs (all clubs with SI gear should have at least one laptop)

Splits Printers (2)

Assign to P&D/Schools if needed, else sell to clubs

Stands (7) [2 clear, 2 check, start, finish and download]

Assign to P&D/Schools if needed, else sell to clubs

Trailer

Sell

Trolley

Sell

Big battery

Sell

Battery charger

Sell (DR will buy it)

Inverters (3)

Give away

Power cables*many

Sell

Results printer (A4)

Give away

Control carry belts

Give to whoever wants them

Any club that is running an event and doesn't have gear (e.g. clubs that double book their gear to run MTBO and another event on the one weekend) will just need to borrow from another club (see again strategic plan)

Once gear gone, I quit.
