Victorian Schools MTBO Championships 2011.

These were held on Friday 12th August at Gellibrand Hill.

Some Statistics:

- 188 students entered the championships,
- 165 competed.
- 56 rode Solo, 132 rode Pairs (i.e.66 pairs)
- 47 were girls, 141 were boys.
- Number of schools represented = 8
- 2 x new schools this year – Mowbray and St Leonards
- 9 riders had maximum points = 550
- 19 riders received time penalties (over 2 hrs)
- 13 riders were more than 10 mins late (no time/ score recorded)

It was a glorious day at Woodlands Historic Park.

Re OA Magazine Order

I have been querying the number of magazines Victoria has as its default number (315) because OV membership and its OA magazine requirement is far lower. OV has 280 memberships, plus 14 schools and one organisation it is required to send OA mags. Total = 295. This means that OV is paying FULL PRICE (\$6.55) for an additional 55 magazines. The process is that any additional order above the State default nos. are charged out at only \$1.50 being for promotion. OV's number has been incorrect for a long time. Who actually supplies this figure to OA? I understand OV is locked in for 12 months, but it is imperative it is correct for 2012.
