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#### ACTIVITIES & PLANS

##### 1) Participation for Winter series 1 (to July 4):

- Monday series: average of 54 participations per night, Total participation 805
- Wednesday series: average of 88 participations per night, Total participation 1320
- Saturday series: average of 63 participations per Sat, Total participation 750
- Overall participations for first half of season 2875. Cold wet weather has impacted some events notably recent Mondays.

##### 2) Sprint into Spring planning:

- Course setting guidelines and planning templates are currently being sent out to all course setters. The final ones to be sent when setters return from overseas travel.
- All SIS maps have been confirmed and approvals gained.
- Vic Champs map approvals still in progress and is being managed with campus by Steve Bird
- Program is on website; Katherine Dent is designing flyer

##### 3) Aus Champs StreetO and Sprint update:

- Good number of early entries indicates high participation levels for both events.
- Maps and courses 90% final
- Organisational details nearing completion
- Promotion to Melbourne streetO population underway; plan to increase effort in August

##### 4) Donation of mobile conferencing unit to OV:

In order to open up the OV council meetings to people who cannot attend in person, a donation of a Plantronics Mobile conferencing unit has been made to OV specifically for use at board and council meetings.

##### 5) Summer fixturing:
