

## **SPORTIDENT ELECTRONIC TIMING SYSTEM**

The SportIdent electronic timing system is used in Victoria for State Series and local events with line courses, including MelbushO, VicbushO, Bendigo local events, and Sprint Into Spring. SportIdent (SI) sticks are worn by each competitor. These are used to record the competitors' times for the event and to confirm that competitors have visited all controls in the correct order.

SportIdent sticks are available for purchase at most Sunday events from the "SI Shop" run by Ian Dodd. A stick personalization service is offered and a register of all sticks owned in Victoria is also maintained by Ian Dodd.

SI sticks are also available for hire at any event using SportIdent. The OV hire sticks are maintained by Ian Dodd and clubs wishing to have them available at their events need to book them using the booking system described below. There is a levy incurred for use of the OV hire sticks at any event below State Series level (ie club/local events).

OV also owns several laptops with licenced event software, printers, and power supply equipment. The O-Lynx Touch system can be used for on the day registration at events using Sportident. This comprises 2 tablet PCs with licenced software, and associated control units.

### **Additional SportIdent equipment**

A number of Victorian clubs – AW, BG, BK, DR, EU, NE and YV – own their own Sportident equipment. Club sets typically contains 20-30 field controls, a master control, a start, finish and clear control, a download unit, and splits printer. Some clubs also have their own laptops and batteries. Clubs or individuals wishing to borrow a Sportident set should negotiate directly with one of the clubs listed above.
