

OA BADGE SCHEME

Qualification for a Badge

An orienteer shall qualify when 3 badge credits have been earned such that the third credit is attained within two years of attaining the first credit. The year in which the third credit is earned shall be considered as the year in which the badge is earned.

A badge credit shall be earned by bettering the cutoff time for the credit standard appropriate to the relevant age class in an event listed above.

Calculation of badge times

The cut-off times for the appropriate credit standards shall be calculated for each class in each age group according to the following formulae:

A- and E-Classes

Winner's time x 1.25 (Gold credit)

Winner's time x 1.50 (Silver credit)

Winner's time x 2.00 (Bronze credit)

AS or B Classes

For AS classes you can earn only Silver or Bronze credits, and for B classes only Bronze credits.

Winner's time x 1.50 (Silver credit – AS only)

Winner's time x 2.00 (Bronze credit)

Badge credits are not awarded in Power Walkers classes.
