

## **EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE FROM ORIENTEERING VICTORIA**

As a general rule, clubs are expected to provide the equipment necessary for organising events. Orienteering Victoria does, however, keep some specialised equipment which is available for loan to clubs. Those borrowing equipment must return it promptly and immediately notify any loss or breakage.

**Safety Equipment:**

- 1 stretcher
- 2 packs of rescue equipment which include air splints, rope, harness, chemical lights, torch and sleeping bag
- 2 knapsack sprays
- 1 first aid kit
- 4 search party bags

Above Safety Equipment is carried to events with the O Gear shop by Kevin Maloney

- 3 Two way Radios available from the OV Office

**SportIdent Equipment:** Includes computers and software, SI Controls, SI cards for hire and sale, Controls stands, power supply equipment etc.
