

## **INSURANCE - OA POLICY**

OA has an insurance policy covering public liability with a cover of \$20,000,000 and Professional Indemnity with a cover of \$1,000,000 with Sportscover Australia Pty Ltd. Copies of the Certificates of Currency are available from the Orienteering Victoria office or Secretary, and are posted on the OV website.

The name of the Assured is the Orienteering Federation of Australia Inc. (including the Interests of Land Owners of properties used for Orienteering for the conduct of Orienteering only and including the Interests of Land Owners of properties used for Mountain Bike Orienteering for the conduct of Orienteering only).

All voluntary officials, event organisers and course setters are covered while engaged in organising an Orienteering Victoria endorsed orienteering event, only if they are members or registered officials of Orienteering Victoria. An OV endorsed event is one that appears on the OV fixtures or coming events list and/or an event for which an OV levy is paid.

Any private coaching would not be covered, nor would any officials organising an event that is not endorsed by Orienteering Victoria. It is therefore very important to have all orienteering events officially approved as part of the OV fixture before running them. Also, private club events such as club coaching days may not be covered.

### **Insurance Policy for Equipment**

Orienteering Victoria has a contents, fire and theft policy to cover equipment stored and used at the OV Office, and equipment stored at the Equipment Officer's premises at John Sheahan's residence. SportIdent equipment and laptops at Ian Chennell's residence are also covered. In addition, the Sportident equipment and laptops are covered by a Marine Transit policy for fire, flood, collision, overturning of conveying vehicle, and theft from locked vehicle or trailer.

### **Emergency Facility and Equipment Replacement Fund**

The Emergency Facility and Equipment Replacement Fund is a statewide funding program to assist local sport and recreation clubs and organisations to replace essential sporting and first aid equipment lost or destroyed as a consequence of fire, theft or flood. Up to 50% of the value, subject to a maximum of \$2000, may be compensated through this program.

Applications can be made at anytime. Please provide:

- A full description of the nature and circumstance of the loss.
- Status of insurance cover.
- A police report if appropriate.
- Endorsement of State Sporting Association, Affiliated Association or Regional Sport Assembly
- A list of stolen or damaged equipment is to be supplied together with the cost of replacement from a supplier; and

- Successful recipients will be requested to provide a statement of receipts and payments within 30 days of the expenditure of funds
