

SPORTIDENT ELECTRONIC TIMING & PUNCHING SYSTEM

The SportIdent electronic punching system is used in Victoria for State Series and higher standard events. SportIdent cards are carried by each competitor and these are used to record the competitors' times for the event and to confirm that competitors have visited all controls in the correct order. To do this, the SportIdent card is inserted into a hole in an electronic device (control) at each control stand. SportIdent cards are available for purchase or for hire.

Clubs wishing to use SportIdent for an event should contact Ian Chennell to arrange to collect the equipment and for training in its use. A training manual is also available.

1. Everything has to be signed for on a designated form, and the individual signing as accepting gear takes financial responsibility for it.
2. When any gear is handed on to anyone else, including back to me to go back in the store, the "losing party" draws up a receipt, the "gaining party" signs it and keeps a copy, and then the losing party has to send a copy back to me, either by post or fax, otherwise the last person for whom I hold a signature carries the obligation to pay for everything, even if they don't physically have it any more.
3. I will not be accepting ad-hoc e-mails saying that so-and-so has such-and-such as official notification, nor will I accept things drawn up on pieces of paper using fingernails dipped in tar - I need to get a signature, on the proper form, otherwise the ownership rests with the last signature I hold.
4. There is a definite financial incentive for any person handing gear on directly to another club to get a signature from the person they hand it on to, then fax the form back to me - until I have that copy, the "ownership" doesn't change over.
5. When I get gear back to go back in the store, I'll sign a form releasing the last custodian from their burden. I intend posting the form I want to use up on the internet somewhere, either on the Orienteering Victoria website, or somewhere else easy to find, and including a whole swag of them in with the gear, so that any club or person can get at it easily at any time – no excuses.

6. I will also require any faulty gear to be returned directly to store for repair, rather than being handed around between clubs for ages without being seen to.
