Defibrillation Kit.

AWOC has enquired about Clubs having a defibrillation Kit in their First Aid Kit. AWOC has opportunity to go for grant thru NSW – I advised to go ahead.

Having completed the 'new' First Aid course recently my recommendation is that considering OV has a large, ageing, active

membership and the chances of heart failure is rising, then OV needs to research defib kits (about \$1250 - \$1950 online) to have with OV First Aid at events.

2015 SRV grant cd cover cost for eg 1 x unit for Bush O events.

To cover all scenarios OV would need :

Park and Street O x 2, Melb Bush O x 1, MTBO x 1, Bush O x 1 (total = 5). If each Club had defib kit x 10.

At times grants are available for Clubs to apply for 'safety' gear. Not usually available for SSA's.

SRV 3 year report

The three years of SRV funding are coming to an end. The grant was for the 2012 – 2015 period. The deadline for the final report was 12 June. Report emailed 9th June.

Ruth Goddard signed off on the Finances.

What next re SRV funding?

I have been informed that SRV will have a 6 month roll over period. Sports will receive 50% of their grant i.e. OV wd receive \$20,000 for 6 months July to December 2015. Nothing in writing yet from SRV.

SRV grant for next permanent course

Approval has been granted by Darebin Parklands Committee of Management for OV(MFR) to install a 30 post permanent course in the park.

NEXT STEPS?

1. On site visit with RIC to approve each site (PW)
2. Finalize partnership between DPCoM and OV (MFR) re obligations eg maintenance, reporting of damage (PW/ MFR)
3. Ordering of posts from Replas (PW)
4. Installation – depending on quote maybe installed by Replas / or volunteers from MFR.

VicHealth follow up to unsuccessful grant application.

Had a 36 minute phone link up with Vic Health officer- Russell Higgings. I wondered how well OV application had been read? VH wd have liked OV to focus more on developing the 'new' events (MelBushO / Spring into Spring) to new target audiences. Did not see the school students as 'new'. Saw Scouts/ venturers as 'new'.
