<b>Any recommended actions required</b> Entry numbers have been generally falling at MTBO events over the last few years. We are concerned that clashes with MelBushO events at our next few events drop entries to near non-viable numbers should orienteers choose to compete in Melb rather than travel. Need to look at ways to avoid clashes in future. The final Summer MTBO lost approx 25% of the field when regular MTBOers chose to go to the State Series Foot O the next morning.
